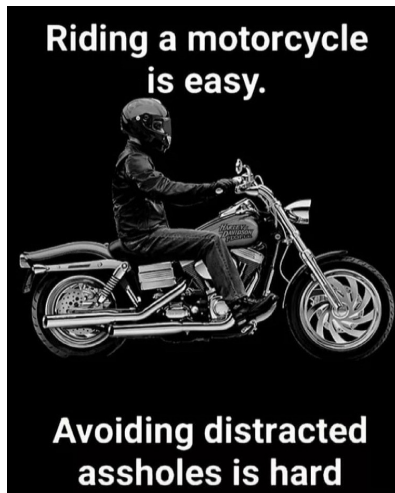

We are very pleased to have Motorcycle Awareness to prominent in DeKalb, DuPage, and Kane County.



Did you pay attention to the elections on April 6th? The voter turnout was horrendous, but luckily for our chapter we had a lot of good luck with local candidates that are great for motorcyclists. Candidates like Geneva Mayor Kevin Burns and Elburn President Jeff Walter were re-elected, and Maple Park President Suzanne Fahnestock and Sugar Grove President Jennifer Konen were elected. These are all great for DuKane A.B.A.T.E.! And congratulations to DuKane A.B.A.T.E. Legislative Coordinator Randy Ramey who was re-elected Wayne Township Supervisor. Elections are so important for our organization. Not just on a state level, but on a local level as well. Do not forget this!!



Speaking of Randy Ramey, he and I attended A.B.A.T.E. of Illinois Legislative Day on April 14th and participated in virtual meetings with State Legislators about motorcyclists' rights in Illinois. It was a very interesting event as this was the first time we were not allowed in the capital building to lobby. I am very happy to say, though, that we did not let the COVID-19 nonsense stop us from doing the work we need to do for motorcyclists/off-roaders/ATV riders in Illinois. We did manage to start heated conversations on the Illinois House Floor pertaining to Trailer Plate Fees and it sounds like an agreement to lower them is coming. Stay tuned!

State Representative Lance Yednock's bill HB2617 (motorcyclist profiling) has moved out of committee and is on it's way to the House Floor. With everything happening with the Illinois Gaming Board in Rockford and the outright profiling to motorcycle clubs in our area, this is extremely important. Hello All,

Legislative Day was a success and I suggest you attend if you haven't in the past. Great to see old friends and mingle with the legislators. We were able to speak to many via Zoom and get their opinions on our legislation. Gubernatorial candidate Senator Bailey stopped by the reception and was in great spirits. We were very appreciative of all who came by!

HB 36 has been sent back to rules as has HB 682. Normally this would spell doom for bills but in speaking with Senator Cullerton there may be some action. He promised to take sponsorship and either move it for the permanent plate at the one time fee of \$118 or move the annual fee to a compromised number that he thinks we would all agree on...\$69. We shall see but call his office to show support.

HB 2617 has moved to second reading on the House floor. This means it has been introduced and as I understand there is some discussion with the State Police on language. Hopefully an agreement can be reached and it moves to third reading. That would mean it would be up for debate on the House floor and voted upon. If this moves then you will be informed to contact your legislators for support.
