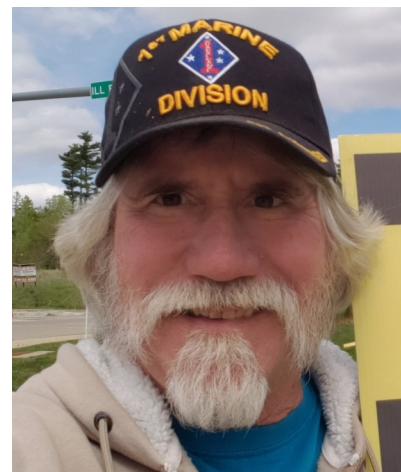

# Legislative Representative; Randy Ramey

Hello All,

The Governor has finally signed SB 58, the TA plate fee which changes from \$118 to \$36 starting Jan. 1, 2022. There was a lot of hard work put in to get legislators on board and to get it moved through the House and the Senate. Thank you for reaching out to your legislators and letting them know your opinions.

Other legislation that ABATE supported and the Governor signed:

HB 96 - updated to allow brain injury as a medical condition allowing for tinted windows above legal limits. ABATE agreed to support the bill when our concerns on the bad bill language were addressed.

HB 656 - ABATE wrote compromise language that states a passenger must be able to touch a footrest. Riders are allowed to modify their footrests to accommodate shorter riders. Creates a clear legal standard and avoids unnecessary stops by law enforcement.

SB 1231 - Allows Polaris to sell a Large Off highway Vehicle (greater than 65" in Width, less than 75") but does not allow the vehicle to be on DNR protected trails. Allows an additional 1000lbs in current OHV weights for electric OHVs only.

These laws take effect on January 1, 2022.

The legislature will be coming back into session to sign off on an energy bill and re-districting the re-districting. The energy bill is allow ComEd and Ameren to raise rates to support their nuclear energy plants, close coal burning plants and turn more towards renewable energies. Basically it will be a fee hike to you and me.

Re-districting or the re-map was set but the census numbers came in and the legislature made mistakes...oops. Now there will be changes to the legislative and congressional maps to better represent certain populations. Watch to see if you will have the same representatives and district numbers. With the primary being moved to June of 2022, I am sure there will be more gerrymandering to come with more challenges to follow. Should be interesting.
