There have been a lot of questions as to why A.B.A.T.E. of Illinois has gotten involved in the Electric Vehicle situation in Illinois. With the energy bill that passed in Illinois (See Randy's article) and Joe Biden's \$1.2 Trillion Infrastructure Bill that have passed, a lot of focus has been placed on Electric Vehicles and the charging network. What's the problem with this you may ask? The problem with this is that Governor JB Pritzker and Deputy Governor Christian Mitchell have said that in Illinois, motorcycles are not primary modes of transportation and shouldn't be included in any of the EV incentives or planning (including infrastructure). THIS IS A PROBLEM. I understand that many of you aren't EV Motorcycle riders, and that's ok. What's not ok is excluding motorcycles in Illinois, and that's what Pritzker and Mitchell have attempted to do. If we as members of A.B.A.T.E. say "well, it's only EV Motorcycles, who cares?" then we are allowing that door to remain open to excluding motorcycles from transportation and infrastructure in the future. Are you ok with that? I'm not. Government overreach by telling me that as a motorcyclist, I don't matter? NO WAY! So, what can we do?

As always keep your memberships up to date, and get those friends and family members, to join DuKane ABATE, we cannot fight for our rights without support from our members.

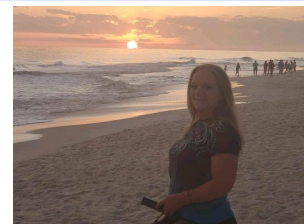

Hello, y'all. I'm attempting to engage in this newsletter, that Michael Nicholson creates every month to give our members some insight from the BOD. As the DuKane ABATE Treasurer here goes my insight.

Well, the one thing that won't be in print is the balances in our accounts. As a DuKane member you are entitled to know that and I will meet with you to show you those balances.



DuKane ABATE benefits for our members and their families is that there is a Downrider's fund available to our members/families if there is financial assistance needed for those who have been involved in injury and or death. We all pray no one needs to use these benefits but there here if needed.

It's almost tax season for Abate, the 990s are due on the 1st of the year and given to ABATE of Illinois Treasurer Paul Traux for approval. All I'm waiting for is expenses and income for December.

Here's some insight into the income DuKane receives. Normally income comes from membership, any donations given by the year's end, or a run put together. In membership, DuKane makes \$3 for single and \$6 for five-year memberships, ABATE of Illinois gets the remaining amount. So ABATE of Illinois can stand strong and fight for those motorcycle rights.

Legislative Representative; Randy Ramey

Hello All,

With all the discussion on motorcycles being left out of the Climate and Equitable Jobs Act (Public Act 102-0662), we should thank Senator Cullerton for introducing SB 2408 which fixed that mistake. His bill did not move forward but he kept his word on it's introduction. This moved Senator Stadelman to keep his word and he added language in Amendment 4 to HB 1769, the Reimagining Electric Vehicles in Illinois Act, removing electric motorcycles from an exclusion to the definition of "electric vehicle". This act was signed into law on October 28th. With this inclusion, electric motorcycles and their specific needs will be a part of grid as it is developed throughout Illinois. A big thanks to those who contacted their legislators and especially those who posted pictures with their bikes showing that motorcycles are an everyday mode of transportation.



As mentioned before, the legislature will be working on a shortened schedule this spring with the intent to finish April 8th. They will be working the same amount of days so they will be in Springfield more than in their district offices. Deadlines for Senate substantive bills is January 21 and for the House is January 28th. Since it is an election year, I don't foresee controversial legislation coming out but we'll be watching to make sure. Hopefully ABATE'S agenda will be distributed soon. The ABATE of Illinois Legislative Day has been moved up to February 16th. This is a great time to visit legislators and see ABATE friends from around the state. Please try to arrange for your participation, strength in numbers as they say!

There will be a hearing in a 3 judge federal court the week of Dec. 6th to hear 3 consolidated cases challenging the new legislative maps. Draft maps have been submitted to the court for review. It's not likely anything will change but it will be interesting to hear the arguments. Both the legislative and the congressional maps that were passed by the Illinois legislature are gerrymandered crap! But under law, political gerrymandering is allowed. The cases being brought forth will attempt to show minority disenfranchisement which is unconstitutional. Over the years the map process has been attempted to be removed from the legislatures' hands but to no avail. Many states use computer models with up-to-date statistical data to create contiguous and compact maps that are fair to all. Regrettably, the party in charge refuses to follow that path.

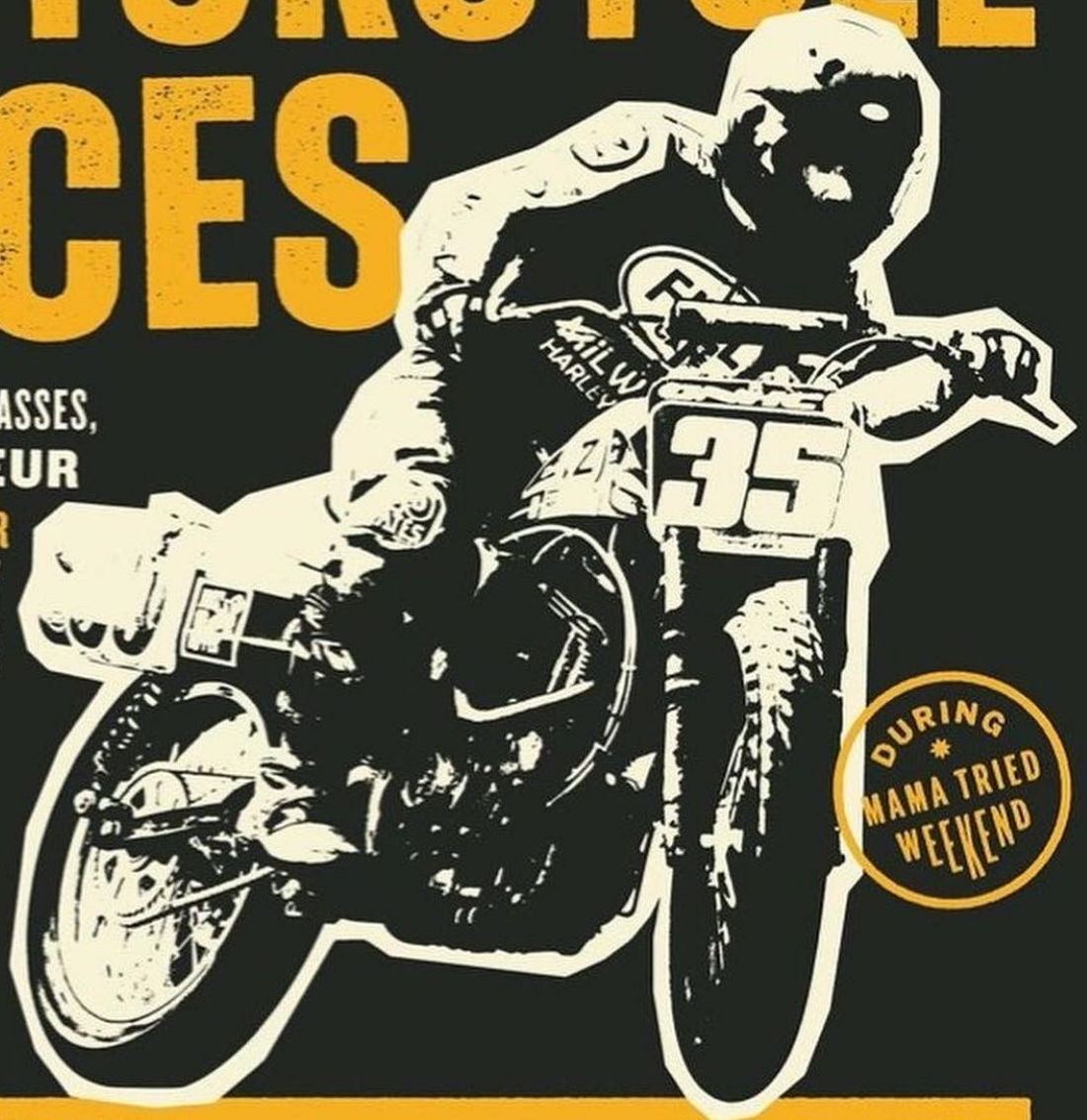

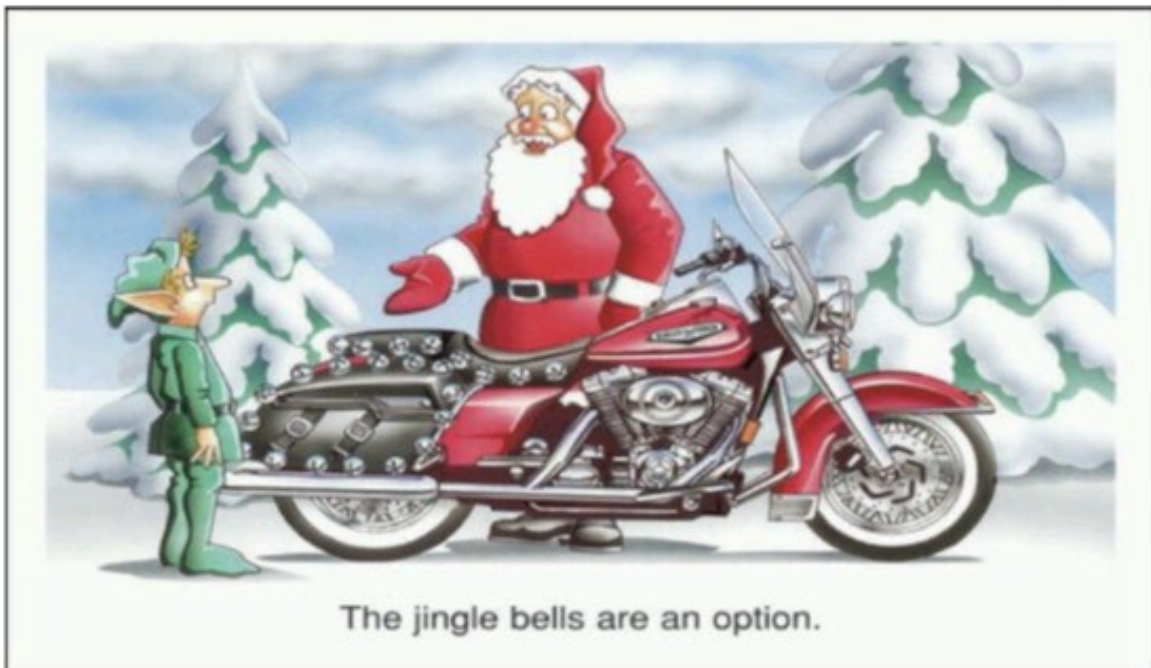
