Hello DuKane A.B.A.T.E.!



This is 100% despicable and wrong. DuKane A.B.A.T.E. will continue to fight against motorcyclist profiling in DuPage and Kane County and will not stop until it is gone. 

ELECTIONS HAVE CONSEQUENCES!

If you do not participate then there is no reason to complain. There are plenty of ways to vote: by mail, early and on the day of election so there is no excuse.

Applications for vote by mail are being accepted now and the ballots will be sent out starting on September 29th. Last day to request it is November 3rd. The envelope must have a stamped date of November 8 or earlier.

Early voting sites will open October 24th and close November 7th. They are distributed throughout our 2 counties.



Last day to register to vote is October 11th. Grace period registration is October 12th thru November 7th.

Election day is November 8th, polls are open from 6:00AM to 7:00PM.

GOVERNOR'S HIGHLIGHTS:

Midwest Hydrogen Coalition: Illinois joined six other Midwestern states in the development of the Midwest Hydrogen Coalition, an agreement that the state's hope will boost decarbonization efforts. The coalition includes Michigan, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Kentucky, Ohio, Indiana and Illinois. The coalition will collaborate with leaders in industry, academia, and community engagement.

Illinois State Board of Education: Dr. Steven Isoye was appointed to chair the Illinois State Board of Education effective immediately. Dr. Isoye replaces Darren Reisberg, who served as chair for the past two years.

Illinois Department of Employment Security: The U.S. Department of Labor awarded the Illinois Department of Employment Security a \$6.8 million equity grant which will allow the agency to better understand and address equity gaps within the state's unemployment insurance (UI) system.

IDES plans to leverage the equity grant to fund four major equity projects which will use expanded data to identify potential inequities in the unemployment pipeline within underrepresented groups. The Department intends to refine UI service delivery systems, processes, and communications for more equitable access and experience, including making UI information easier to understand, translating information into multiple languages, expanding self-service digital options, and increasing outreach to community level organizations.

Executive Order: Executive Order 2022-20 Reissues previous Executive Orders related to the COVID-19 pandemic through October 15, 2022.

102nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

Senator Emil Jones, III is being charged in federal court with three criminal counts related to his dealings with a red-light camera company. Jones, who is the son of former Senate President Emil Jones II, has served in the Senate since 2009 when he was appointed to replace his father. Senate President Don Harmon called the allegations “grave” and asked for and received Senator Jones’ resignation as Deputy Majority Leader, Chairman of the Senate Licensed Activities Committee and Vice-Chair of the Public Safety Committee effective immediately.



Governor Pritzker is now calling for Senator Jones and Senator Hastings, who is also facing allegations of misconduct, to resign. The Governor stated “They should answer the charges and have their day in court. But in the best interests of their constituents, these men must resign from their offices. Resigning only their leadership roles falls short of what the public should expect. I want to send a clear message to the people of Illinois: corruption and abuse have no place here.”

Jones is running unopposed in the November election. Hastings, who calls the allegations politically motivated, faces Republican Patrick Sheehan in November.

Treasurer: Mark Del Monaco

Bills are paid, deposits have been deposited, bank statements are balanced, all is well with our treasury.



The next treasury activity is, obviously, the Toy and Food Run event. This event has the most donations, expenses, rentals, admission income, product sales, membership sign ups, logistics, etc. of the year. Thank God for Chris Newman! I reviewed previous year’s accounting and as I discussed at a prior member meeting, I have prepared a proforma worksheet to track income, expenses, and value-add transactions, and the worksheet is linked into the 990 summary worksheet so it automatically totals for year-end tax reporting. I expect to have to trace and validate every formula to ensure the accounting cross-foots, but the plan is in place and should be just a matter of due diligence (that’s what I said to myself; do it; it’ll be fun!)

Relative to closing our Toy & Food Run and Downed Rider bank accounts and consolidating them as budget items in our General account, the board and I agreed it would be better to extend this transition to the end of the year as the transition date. As a reminder, the purpose of doing this is to simplify the monthly accounting to just one account, focus our business on an operations-based budget, and minimize the complexity of summarizing three accounts for tax reporting to just one. As you can imagine, this will simplify the audit process and ease the transition to whomever eventually next takes over as Treasurer.

I’m really looking forward to this year’s Toy and Food Run. I worked the stage and security in prior years; this is my first year as Treasurer.
