Hello All,

103rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

The Illinois House reconvenes on Tuesday, February 28 for three days of session. The Senate is off this week and will reconvene on Tuesday, March 7.

Bill Introduction deadlines have passed in both chambers. In total, 2,442 Senate Bills and 3,974 House Bills were filed prior to the deadline. Of those, 1,901 Senate Bills remain in the Senate Assignments Committee while 2,150 House Bills remain in the House Rules Committee.



Friday, March 10 is the deadline to pass substantive Senate Bills and House Bills out of Committee in the chamber of origin. The Senate has one session week left prior to the committee deadline; the House has two session weeks prior to the committee deadline.

Governor Pritzker appointed Representative Fran Hurley to the Labor Relations Board. Hurley is expected to resign her seat by the end of the month. Local Democrats will have one month from the creation of the vacancy to fill the appointment.

GOVERNOR'S HIGHLIGHTS:

Executive Order: In order to allow the state to better mobilize and coordinate response efforts during any future disasters and emergencies, the Governor is changing the name (and scope) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security (IEMA-OHS).

Executive Order 2023-03 will include review and discussion by both the Illinois House and Senate and will go into law 60 days after submission unless affirmatively disapproved by one of those chambers. The transition will be phased over the next one to two years, and when complete, will provide IEMA-OHS with administrative capabilities to help respond to disasters, threats, or emergencies more effectively.

New Laws: Governor Pritzker signed **SB 1001** which reduces the fees for First Class Wine Makers.

Bond Rating Upgraded: S&P Global Ratings upgraded Illinois bonds, for the third time since July of 2021. S&P Global upgraded Illinois' rating on its General Obligation bonds to A- (stable outlook) from BBB+ (stable outlook) and upgraded Build Illinois sales tax bonds to A (stable outlook) from A- (stable outlook).

Reproductive Freedom Alliance: Governor JB Pritzker will join the Reproductive Freedom Alliance (RFA), a non-partisan group of state Governors focused on working alongside one another to identify best practices for legislative and executive action to protect reproductive rights. The RFA will work in partnership with The Raben Group to facilitate conversations and share information on successes and risks in the fight for reproductive justice. Twenty states have signed on to the Alliance: California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Hawaii, Illinois, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Washington, and Wisconsin.

Unsewered Communities Construction Grants: The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency awarded \$21,046,025 in grants to six communities across the State through EPA's Unsewered Communities Construction Grant Program (UCCGP). This is the second of five planned funding rounds for this program, which provides funding to areas currently without wastewater collection and/or treatment facilities.

Gubernatorial Appointments: Governor Pritzker appointed the following:

- Arnie Rivera will serve as the new chair of the Illinois Tollway Board
- James Rivera has been appointed to serve as Illinois State Fire Marshal
- Alyssa Murphy will serve as a Member of the Illinois Racing Board
- Angela Oberreiter will continue to serve as a member of the State Board of Health
- Fran Hurley will serve as a Member of the Illinois Labor Relations Board
- Michelle Hoy-Watkins will serve as a Member of the Illinois State Police Merit Board
- Mona Noriega will continue to serve Chair of the Human Rights Commission

OTHER NEWS:

Gun Violence Grants: In response to high levels of gun violence experienced since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Illinois Department of Human Services Office of Firearm Violence Prevention (OFVP), together with Cook County's Justice Advisory Council (JAC), announced \$25 million in grants to fund 74 service providers focused on supporting residents at risk of experiencing gun violence in Chicago and Suburban Cook County.

BIPA Court Ruling: Last Friday, in a divided ruling, the Illinois Supreme Court ruled that claims under Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act (BIPA) accrue every time the law is violated – or each time a person's biometric data is scanned and transmitted without prior consent.

SAFE-T Act: The Illinois Supreme Court is scheduled to hear oral arguments regarding the elimination of cash bail under the SAFE-T Act on March 14.

- ✓ **T** **Tires.** Check air pressure, wheels, brakes and spokes.
- ✓ **C** **Controls.** Check levers, hoses, cables and throttle.

Treasurer: Mark Del Monaco

When I was a yout', and I don't know why, but I was enamored by Arlo Guthrie's song, The Significance of the Pickle - look it up "...I don't want to die, I just want to ride on my motorcy - - - cle". Waiting patiently for this cold, wind, and rain to clear, I'm having cabin fever for a sunny two-lane road surrounded by corn fields and small towns. But, in the interim, I'm bit-banging in Excel preparing formulas for budgets.



Paul Truax, our Abate-IL treasurer, responded to our 990 tax summation submission and accepted our report. In general terms, our treasury is a couple thousand dollars over our starting balance in Jan 2022. That means 2023 is fully funded and additional fund raising will go toward 2024. This is good news because it provides the expenditure baseline for 2023's events and the possibility to consider enhancing the marketing, advertising, and amenities for 2023's events. Plus, based on budget planning and forecasted fundraising, we might be able to consider adding new events, or other applicable activities and/or education benefits, especially for 2024.

I closed the Toy & Food and Downed Rider bank accounts. Everything has been consolidated into the General account. Similar to logging a 990 tax category per bank transaction, I have set up a column to assign a Budget category per transaction. At this point, 11 budget categories have been identified:

- 1 General – supplies, multi-use inventories, bank fees, DuKane Abate advertising, wish-list budgeting, etc.
- 2 Donations – Donations credited/debited. As a 501c4 Not for Profit Organization, we are not allowed to make donations to charities.
- 3 Membership – Membership fees go to Abate-IL and a refund is credited to our General budget.
- 4 Downed Rider – Benevolence contributions provided to members.
- 5 Travel – Fuel/milage, hotel, food, etc. for any DuKane Abate related travel.
- 6 Santa Girls – new... not 100% certain what funding is required.
- 6 Awareness – Motorcycle Awareness Day event.
- 8 BBWash – Bikini Bike Wash event.
- 9 ABC – Abate Bowling Classic event.
- 10 ToyFood – Toy & Food Run event.
- 11 Holiday – Budgeting for all holiday activities – currently Thanksgiving and Christmas.
